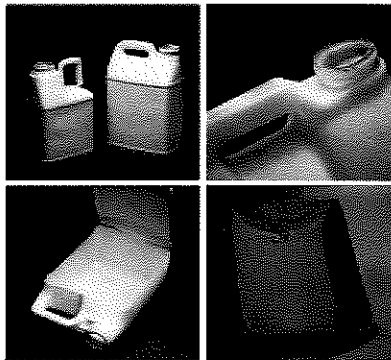
WHERE: Ida Co-Op West

Growers will be able to recycle containers **free of charge** (no limit)

How to prepare the containers for recycling?

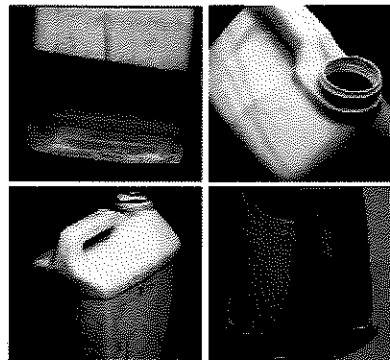
- Triple rinse, remove caps, remove loose leaf labels (if possible), put in large/clear plastic bags OR string together 20-30 containers with twine – if the containers are not up to these standards, they will not be accepted.
- ONLY non-refillable, #2 high-density polyethylene (HDPE) plastic crop protection and specialty pesticide containers 55 gallons and smaller.
- Containers that originally held consumer products, or home and garden pesticides will not be accepted.

Containers caked with residue,
dried formulation on container and
thread or liquid residue present.
